Practice:

Kindness Small Animal Hospital – Dr. Aron Neeman

Condition:

Shay presented on 3/29/11 after being hit by a car. She had a large suspected right side abdominal muscular hernia. Exploratory surgery was performed by our local referral surgical center and all was clear.

She represented to the surgical center on 4/15/11 for extensive caudo-dorsum and lateral skin sloughing. The owners were considering euthanasia, but consented to surgical debriding and treatment, which included wet-to-dry bandages. The surgeon contacted me on 4/27 to discuss how the wounds were being treated, and that she was showing slow improvement. He referred her back to me for K-Laser Therapy treatment. (see Image)

K-Laser Protocols:

Contaminated Wound at 5 Watts 2 full treatments to cover entire area (1125 Joules).

Treatment Frequency:

Daily 4/28 through 5/2 then once weekly.

Additional Therapies / Modalities:

Twice-daily hydrotherapy – 10 minutes per session

Outcomes / Prognosis:

5/11 with remarkable improvement (see image).

Additional Notes:

Shay also has a fibular fracture for which she was splinted by the surgeon for 4 weeks. She continued to be nonweight bearing lame until we did 2 laser treatments on the leg. She now uses it without a limp!
