Horse was a runaway at race track. He got loose from handler and tried to stop on asphalt. The horse fell and had multiple injuries. 3 days prior to the pictures below

One hour after the first treatment

1 hour later after first laser



This page represents the progression of the results for the following days of treatments.

Three treatments the first week  
2 treatments the second and third weeks. Then once a week.

Normally wounds of this sort can take months to heal. Note the last image is 29 days from initial treatment. No other treatments were used, except betadine to clean the area of the wound.
