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Class IV Laser for Pain

Case Study: Multiple Fractures, 7 screws, stabilizing plate, open wound, edema, possible skin graft

History:

On October 1 2008 Trevor was performing one of his professional 80 foot motorcycle jumps. This time something went wrong and Trevor hit the ramp short crushing both feet, and also multiple fractures in the Left hand and wrist. The doctors had to literally screw him back together. Seven screws and a plate in the Right foot, several in the Left and Left wrist. As the result of the injury he was told that he wouldn't be able to walk for 6 months to 1 year. The resulting surgery on this right foot for the screws and plate appeared not to heal and the doctors were worrying that he would require a skin graft to help the wound heal.

Our first treatment on Trevor was on 11-12-2008 exactly 43 days after the injury.

We were treating his ankle and foot for the pain. But something else remarkable happen. Notice the changes in the swelling, wound and scar.

7 Days and two (2) treatments with the Class IV K Laser



80% of his foot pain/numbness was relieved after his first treatment.

This is two weeks later and a total of 4 laser treatments

14 Days and four (4) treatments with the Class IV K Laser



After four treatments no skin graft needed
