**Case Study: 14 ST-B2 2009**

Strep B and Fracture repair of talus. Six surgeries in seven months to repair the open wound edema with possible skin graft required

**History:**

Most injuries to the talus result from motor vehicle accidents, although falls from heights also can injure the talus. The fracture was sports related, from high jumping. In April 2009 he received his first of six surgeries. The first in April 2009 to repair or remove some bone fragments. The next five surgeries were to repair and remove Strep B infected tissue from the original incision. The tissue was not healing and the doctors were concerned it would require a skin graft.

On Dec 1, 2009, two days after his sixth surgery we started his first Klaser treatment. On the next **nine treatments over a 44 day period**, we used special protocols with the K1200 Class IV Klaser.

Two days after the sixth surgery and 7 months after the initial surgery the wound continued to looked like this.



Initial injury prior to Klaser treatment

We were treating his ankle and foot for the pain. But something else remarkable happen. Notice the changes in the swelling, wound and scar.

**14 Days and two (4) treatments with the Class IV K Laser**



Remember the opening had been there for 6 months with no healing and his foot pain/numbness was relieved after his first treatment. **14 Days and four (4) treatments with the Class IV K Laser no skin graft needed**

**44 days Later vs 6 month's & 5 surgeries**



This is **44 days later** and a total of **9 laser treatments**
